EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT (ED)

We are a Level III ED providing emergency care, including cardiology, neurology, trauma and pediatrics, to approximately 60,000 patients each year. Our 28-bed ED consists of three triage rooms, 25 treatment rooms and a three-bay Fast Track area. Our nurse-to-patient ratio is 1:3 with the physician and nurse practitioner model. To meet the needs of our community, we have expanded three times since opening in 2012 with plans for future additions.

MEDICAL-SURGICAL UNIT

The Medical-Surgical Unit offers an expansive work environment with 46 beds. Our nurses can expect to expand their critical thinking and nursing skills while caring for a wide variety of neurological, cardiac and surgery patients. We promote nursing excellence and provide opportunities for career growth and advancement. Choose from a variety of nursing positions, including RN staff and float pool. The nurse-to-patient ratio is 1:5.

PROGRESSIVE CARE UNIT (PCU)

Our 17-bed PCU works to transition critical care patients of all ages out of ICU. Nurses here are exposed to a variety of medical conditions and co-morbidities, enriching their knowledge of disease progressions with opportunities to expand their clinical skills. The nurse-to-patient ratio is 1:4.

INTENSIVE CARE UNIT (ICU)

Our eight-bed ICU cares for the most critical patients admitted to the hospital. We treat a variety of medical conditions, including cardiac issues, respiratory failure, sepsis, diabetic ketoacidosis, overdose/substance abuse, and more. Nurses routinely encounter wound management, titration of medications/drips and ventilator management. We offer extensive training in technical skills and critical thinking to prepare you to care for the most critical patients. The nurse-to-patient ratio is 1:2.

MATERNITY SERVICES

Our Maternity Services includes a 10-bed Labor & Delivery (L&D) Unit, 19-bed Mother Baby (MB) Unit and a 10-bed Level II Special Care Nursery. Our hospital delivers approximately 1,500 babies a year and cares for infants 32 weeks gestation and greater. Nurses with prior L&D experience are cross trained for MB, allowing for a variety of acuity and pace. Once a new maternity nurse gains experience on our MB unit, they can be cross-trained to the nursery or L&D at their preference. Nurse-to-patient ratios are 1:1 or 1:2 on L&D and 1:3 couplets on MB.

SURGICAL & ENDOSCOPY SERVICES

Surgical & Endoscopy Services offers a variety of nursing and clinical staffing opportunities from pre-operative patient care, operating room and procedural care, to post-anesthesia care. With seven ORs and three endoscopy suites, we care for approximately 500-600 surgical and endoscopy patients per month plus numerous procedural and clinic patients. We offer a variety of services, including minimally-invasive vascular procedures, general surgery, OB-GYN surgery, orthopedic surgery, EGD/colonoscopy, plastic surgery, robotic surgery, ophthalmology and some urology. Structured training programs include classroom and clinicals for non-experienced OR nurses and scrub assistants.

CASE MANAGEMENT

Case managers coordinate hospital and post-discharge services that ensure high quality and cost-effective care for our patients. We work with insurance companies to determine if patients meet the medical necessity requirements so the hospital stay is covered. We collaborate with patients, families, physicians and post-acute care providers to provide our patients with a safe discharge plan.



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
